

What a dollar can do . . .

When given through the Callaway County United Way

(These are only a few examples of the more than 200 programs and services provided by our current 13 CCUW partner agencies)

\$1 donation per week (\$52/year):

- will provide 90 meals to a family who would otherwise go without.
- will pay for a single counseling session for a person looking for direction after a major disruption to their life.
- will provide a domestic violence victim with a safety plan and registration in the Missouri Safe-at-Home Program so that an abuser will not know the new physical location for them or their children.
- will provide 3 hours of home cleaning, laundry or bathing services for someone who is elderly or disabled.
- will send 1 youth, 14 years or older, to 4-H counselor camp for leadership training.
- will provide the funding for 3 hours of CASA volunteer training.
- will make it possible for 2 youth to attend a scout day camp.
- will provide 23 hot meals at Kingdom Projects for their disabled employees.
- will provide a domestic violence victim and children 1 night of emergency shelter.

\$2 donation per week (\$104/year):

- will pay for 42 in-town trips for persons needing rides to the store or to work.
- will pay for an individual to attend an 8-week group related session for parenting drug or alcohol issues.
- will provide fuel for 2 trips to pick up food for the SERVE pantry from the Food Bank.
- will provide 2 nurse visits by a RN to a diabetic for medication teaching, diabetic foot care or to teach a family member to set up medications correctly.

\$5 donation per week (\$260/year):

- will provide utility assistance to 2 families in a month during heating and cooling seasons.
- will provide 6+ trips to Audrain, Boone or Cole counties to receive chemotherapy or dialysis treatments for those who do not have Medicaid or other coverage.
- will purchase 2 bath benches, 1 shower chair and 1 bedside commode for the Outreach Loaner program.
- will provide the materials and equipment needed to provide 3 full CASA volunteer training classes.

\$10 donation per week (\$520/year):

- will provide 150 meals to homebound senior citizens.
- will provide over 500 pounds of food to the food pantry.
- will transport 40,000 pounds of food to the food pantry.
- will provide 208 in-town trips or 13 round-trips (out-of-county) for local veterans to the VA or to meet other needs.
- will pay for legal representation of a victim in a divorce trial that also will determine child custody and visitation terms.
- will provide 43 hours of respite care for an elderly person with Alzheimer's who cannot safely stay home by themselves while the family has to go to work or needs a break.
- will purchase 20 books and provide a full training for 20 parents for the Health Smiles Program at Head Start.
- will cover the cost of a family of 4 for 1 month at the Haven House.
