\$1 can provide:

- A month's worth of food to a family in need.
- New deadbolt locks to keep a victim and her children safe.
- Juice every day for a year to a homebound elderly person.
- Membership fees for 3 girls to join Girl Scouts.
- Photo IDs for 3 people facing homelessness
- The ability for 2 boys to attend Cub Scouts to Day Camp
- One counseling session for someone facing a challenge in their life.
- A scholarship for 1 young person to attend the Kansas City workforce conference
- A scholarship for 1 child, 11-13, to attend Public Speaking Academy to develop speaking and writing skills in a non-competitive setting.
- Leadership training at counselor camp for one young person over 14.

\$2 can provide

- 2 nights of shelter for an abuse victim and her children.
- Milk every day for a year to a homebound senior citizen.
- 8 eight follow-up support meetings with a CASA volunteer and supervisor
- An attorney to file an order of protection to stop abuse immediately.
- A year of high quality, education-oriented child care for 2 children
- 42 rides to work on the store.
- 2 deliveries from the Food Bank in Columbia
- Enrollment materials for 5 new family beginning their 4-H journey
- Scholarship for a teen age (11-13) to attend Teen Conference on MU campus.
- A monitor at the homeless shelter for one night
- 1 boy with the ability to attend Lake of the Ozarks Scout Reservation
- 8-week group session related to parenting or drug/alcohol issues to 1 person.

\$5 can provide:

- Bus tickets/transportation for a victim and her children fleeing their abuser.
- 200 loaves of bread to home bound senior citizens.
- An attorney for custody and support hearings
- High quality, education-oriented day car for 5 children
- Utility assistance to a family for 2 months.
- 6 trips to Columbia, Mexico or Jefferson City for chemotherapy or dialysis.
- Horseback riding sessions at summer camp for 1 girl.
- Scholarships for 3 youths to attend State 4-H Congress on MU Campus
- Send 2 youths (age 8 to 13) to traditional 4-H camp (Life Skills Development)
- 1 week of utilities for Haven House and Wiley House
- For 8 Cub Scouts to attend Adventure Camp at Lake of the Ozarks Scout Reservation
- 5 family counseling sessions to help parents and children deal more effectively with their problems.

\$10 can provide:

- First month's rent on an apartment for an abuse victim and her children.
- 5 months of nutritious food to a homebound senior citizen
- An attorney to gain a divorce, support and custody arrangements from an abuser.
- 500 pounds of food to the food pantry
- Transport 40,000 pounds of food to the food pantry.
- 208 in town trips or 13 round-trips (out-of-county) for local veterans to the VA or to meet other needs.
- Scholarships for 2 youths for Summers at Mizzou (Career/Leadership Development)
- Transporting 60 youths to Traditional 4-H Camp at Camp Clover Point
- Our House operating expenses for 2 days
- Scholarships for 35 at-risk youth to join Scouting who otherwise would not be able to join due to financial hardships.
- 2 months of therapy for addiction, behavioral issues and depression.
